A Day in the Life of a Version 1

What led you to apply to Version 1?

I finished my Masters in Computer Science from UCD and joined Version 1 soon after as part of the *Accelerate* Graduate programme. Though the process was challenging, I was eager to get a role in Data Analytics and Version 1 offered me that chance. It really pushed me out of my comfort zone and working on a client's site has been a totally new environment for me.

What does your working week look like at a glance?

I am currently working in an exciting Data Analytics position in Dublin where I get to work on the client's site within the Public Sector. I work in a team of two but also get to work alongside the client's own employees often; it's a big workforce with a lot of teams and big technology projects to work on. My day is usually spent alongside my team lead; we have catch-ups everyday to discuss our work. I also get a lot of time to work on projects independently too, which is a great way to learn.

What are the key moments in your day?

Working on site with a client means you are internally focused on their business a lot of the time, so key moments of my day include stand up calls updating them on progress, and updating their scripts to check data counts. I answer business queries throughout the day too, and work to strict deadlines.

What are the best AND most challenging parts of your job?

I enjoy the agile approach to my job. Whilst we do have deadlines, the structure of the working day isn't rigid, so no two days are the same. It makes each week different with new things to learn. The most challenging part for me is meeting deadlines and also answering business queries simultaneously. As a solo developer in my team there has been hard days wherein I have struggled to manage work and meeting deadlines but on the flipside I have grown a great amount from those challenges. I have learnt a lot since I joined Version 1.

What advice would you give to someone looking to join your team?

I believe that anyone looking to work in data and analytics needs to be focused and have a good attention to detail. Working on client site also requires dedication, and it's also important to be honest and open with clients to get the best outcome for them.
