The most rewarding part of my job is the satisfaction I receive when a wide variety of problems faced by my customer are resolved by my team through collaboration. Recognition from the customer is the cherry on the cake. I also enjoy the flexibility to work from home or the office as needed. Not all meetings that I attend are always related to myself or my teams' roles and responsibilities. I would like to have less of those – not so productive – meetings.
