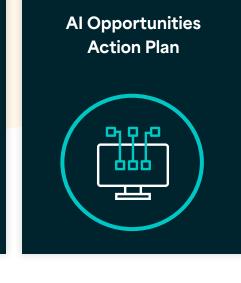


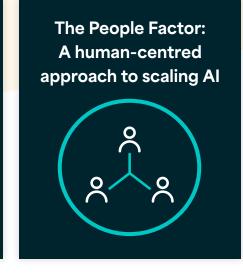
Al in the public sector is shifting gear. **Are you ready?**

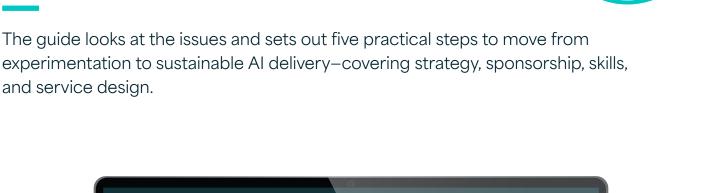
